- 1. Depart following your guide leader, turning right onto E Butler Ave. to avoid traffic.
- 2. At the signalized intersection with S Fourth St, turn left onto Fourth St.
- 3. Cross over I-40 and at the signalized intersection with 89A (Route 66), turn left onto 89A.
- 4. Continue on 89A for 3 miles, enjoying the original alignment of Route 66 through historic Flagstaff.
- 5. As you pass the train station, be sure you are in the right lane. When Route 66 starts to curve left to go under the train bridge, bear right onto Santa Fe Ave.
- 6. Continue on Santa Fe Ave as it becomes Mars Hill Rd. and winds its way up to the Lowell Observatory. Park here. **[Main Stop]**
- 7. Return by retracing your route. At Ponderosa Parkway, turn right and continue as it becomes Butler Ave. Shortly after passing I-40, Little America will be on your right.
